

## **Did You Know**

- In Alberta, 1 in 6 men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in their lifetime and more than 2,700 will be diagnosed with prostate cancer in Alberta this year alone.
- Prostate cancer is the leading form of cancer diagnosed in Canadian men.
- If diagnosed early, prostate cancer is treatable.
- Even when the disease is advanced, treatment can eradicate symptoms and prolong survival.
- Survival rates for prostate cancer have been improving for the last four years.
- Detecting certain types of prostate cancer can be critical.
- Elevated PSA results may reveal prostate cancer that's likely to spread to other parts of your body (metastasize), or they may reveal a quick-growing cancer that is likely to cause other problems.
- Early treatment can help catch the cancer before it becomes lifethreatening or cause serious symptoms.
